Left tower



Make two of everything - as shown in pictures K, G & L's instructions are noted on the appropriate steps


1. Sew two B's to A.



2. Sew two C's to top and bottom of BAB.




3. Sew two H's to right and left of BABCC.





9. Lay I diagonally from bottom right corner to middle top using fold line to find the middle. Have approximately approximately 1.5" overhang off the bottom.



10. Sew where I & J overlap. Trim excess J.



11. Lay I diagonally from bottom left corner to middle top.Have approximately approximately 1.5" overhang off the bottom.





- 12. Square up the base of the triangle. Figure out middle width, which should be around 2". Line that up with the top point of the triangle and trim off all bottom excess fabric. Use the base to square up and trim down sides and top. Total width is 7.5". From middle fold line will be 3.75" each direction
 - I like to leave the top untrimmed until I know that the top middle unit is the size I intended... ...I try to build in and plan for my imperfection :-)






13. Sew roof unit to tower top. Add K to left of left unit and right of right unit. This is what finished tower top units will look like (again disregard flat top on roof)











- 3. Snowball two G's to bottom corners of O.





6. Sew three X's to three R's.





1. Sew top row together - left tower top, middle top, right tower top.







