## Supply List

| BasiCs (On Hand) | Required |

| Sewing machine | Open toed "darning"/ Free Motion Quilting foot for your <br> sewing machine |
| Iron | Coordinating 40wt thread <br> (one spool each for Colors 1, 2, 3 and 4) |
| Pressing surface | Chalk pencil, water soluble pen, or other marking <br> implement |
| Prefered starch | Compass or Circle Rotary cutter <br> (only needed for Saturn Block in Feb) |
| Fabric scissors | Sewing Machine with a zigzag stitch <br> (only needed for Modern Beauty Block in July) |
| Lint roller | Sulky Monofilament Thread <br> (only needed for Modern Beauty Block in July) |
| Basting spray, pins, or thread as <br> prefered | Paper scissors |
| Rotary Cutter | Add a Quarter Plus ruler |
| Cutting Mat | $12.5^{n \prime} \times 12.5^{n}$ ruler for squaring blocks |
| $6 " \times 24 "$ ruler | Fons and Porter Triangle Trimmers |
|  | $1 / 4^{n}$ foot for your sewing machine |

## Fabric Requirements

Note: These are estimated amounts. Many of our blocks are improvisational in nature, so you may wish to buy a little more than is listed here.

- Color 1
- Color 2
- Color 3
- Color 4
- Background Color
- Batting:
- Backing Fabric
- Binding
$\sim 1 / 2$ yard or 4 fat eighths (Orange in example)
$\sim 1 / 2$ yard or 4 fat eighths (Purple in example)
$\sim 1 / 2$ yard or 4 fat eighths (Yellow in example)
$\sim 1 / 2$ yard or 4 fat eighths (Coral/Red in example)
~ 5 yards
Twin sized precut OR 12 17" squares, and $\sim 11 / 4$ yard for the borders.
$\sim 51 / 4$ yards OR 1218 " squares and $\sim 11 / 4$ yard for the borders
~ $1 / 2$ yard
