

## Playful Pinwheels

These instructions are to make a large pinwheel block. Use  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams. Iron seams open to create less bulk at the center of the pinwheel.

1. Pick a solid/semisolid and a colorful coordinating print or ask for a block kit.



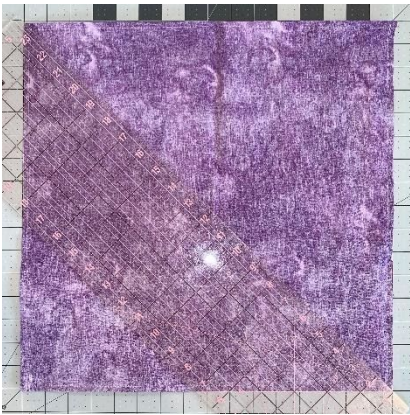
2. Put them right sides together and cut a 16" x 16" square.



3. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam around all four sides.



4. Cut diagonally from one corner to the opposite corner. Making sure to keep cut edges together, cut the other corner to corner.



5. You will have four triangles.



6. Open each triangle. Press seams open.



7. Spin each of the four mini-blocks into a pinwheel design.



8. Sew top two together. Sew bottom two together.



9. Sew top row and bottom row together. End size will be around 21" x 21", but don't worry if it is bigger or smaller. We'll make it work. :-)
